

## ways to give ...

### Give On Sundays

You can give each week by dropping your check in the box at the back of the auditorium or in the offering basket. If you give cash and want a tax deduction there are envelopes by the giving boxes at the back of the auditorium for this purpose.



### Give On Line

Go to [littletonvineyard.org](http://littletonvineyard.org) to set up your regular giving. On the homepage click on the "Give" tab on the right. On the next page "[Click Here](#) to make a donation." This will take you to our secure online giving system. You can give directly from your bank account or through your debit card.



### Give By Mail

You can mail your donation to the Vineyard church office or you can use your bank's 'billpay' service to have checks automatically sent to the Vineyard.



## frequently asked questions ...

### How Much Should I Give?

The Bible calls every follower of Jesus to give generously of the first of their income (not the leftovers). In the Bible, a tithe, or 10% is the amount God calls us to set aside to give to the church. Anything over 10% is called an 'offering' and is a way to support specific projects and to honor God through sacrificial giving.

### Is My Gift Tax Deductible?

All contributions are 100% tax deductible. A giving envelope must be completed in order for a cash gift to be tax deductible. We mail giving statements each year to every person that has donated to the church. These statements can be used with your tax returns to claim your deduction.
